

Wyatt's Warriors Spirit Scholarship

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Wyatt's Warriors Spirit Scholarship is to provide financial assistance to a 2026 high school graduating senior or current college student pursuing further education at a college, university, vocational, or trade school. This scholarship aims to recognize and support individuals who have demonstrated a strong commitment to their community and fellow students. We seek to honor those who consistently show up for others, offering support, encouragement, and assistance when needed, embodying the spirit of Wyatt's Warriors. Through this scholarship, we hope to empower and uplift individuals who exemplify kindness, empathy, and dedication to making a positive difference in the lives of those around them.

VALUE

\$500 minimum scholarship to any college, university, vocational or trade school.

ELIGIBILITY & SELECTION

To be eligible for the scholarship the applicant must meet the following criteria. Each application will be carefully reviewed and the applicant who appears to meet the selection criteria most closely will be chosen. The winner will be announced in May.

- 2026 graduating senior at a school in Eastern Iowa (living within 50 miles of Manchester) that has been accepted to a college, university, vocational, or trade school OR any current college student attending a college, university, vocational, or trade school who is from Eastern Iowa.
- Have demonstrated outstanding leadership and community service.
- Record of participation in volunteer activities in school or in the community.
- Letter of recommendation.

HOW TO APPLY

To be considered for the Wyatt's Warriors Spirit Scholarship, students must submit the below application in addition to one reference letter from a non-related community member.

1. Complete the attached application in its entirety, including the personal statements section.
2. Your reference letter should be from someone in your community. This person can be a community leader, volunteer supervisor, or someone holding a position of responsibility within the community. It is recommended that you ask someone who knows you well and who can speak of your involvement in school and or community activities. This person **cannot** be a relative. Your reference letter should be **one-page** letter outlining your personal characteristics, ability to work with others, participation in volunteer and extracurricular activities and your leadership potential and willingness to be in someone else's corner.
3. Include a personal picture.
4. Applications can either be Emailed with all necessary documentation or mailed to the address below. This includes your completed application, personal statements, personal picture and reference letter. If mailed all items must be sealed in the same envelope. Completed application packages must be received no later than April 1, 2026. Winner will be announced in May.
